



# Installation Site Requirements

## Installation

Where Regency Displays P/L the Supplier is required to install the Goods the Client warrants that the structure of the premises or equipment in or upon which these Goods are to be installed or erected is sound and will sustain the installation and work incidental thereto and Regency Displays P/L the Supplier shall not be liable for any claims, demands, losses, damages, costs and expenses howsoever caused or arising should the premises or equipment be unable to accommodate the installation.

## Access

The Client shall ensure that Regency Displays P/L the Supplier has clear and free access to the work site at all times to enable them to undertake the Services. The Supplier shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the site (including, without limitation, damage to pathways, driveways and concreted or paved or grassed areas) unless due to the negligence of the Regency Displays P/L Supplier.

## Client's Responsibilities

It is the Client's responsibility to meet to safe work practices E.G

- (a) have all areas clean and clear to enable scheduled work to be completed in accordance with the schedule of installation; and
- (b) ensure that the levels of the skirting's are satisfactory as the wall linings can only follow the contours of the skirting and will not correct unevenness; and
- (c) remove all fragile items such as glassware, crockery, pot plants, furniture and ornaments. Breakages and damages are the responsibility of the Client. All care taken but no responsibility accepted by Regency Displays P/L the Supplier in this regard; and
- (d) provide adequate dust sheets to protect the Client's furniture and décor. Regency Displays P/L the Supplier will not accept any responsibility for cleaning or repair costs attributed to dust or damage caused by any sanding process. Flaking or crumbling walls should be temporarily covered by the Client, until the gluing is dry; and
- (e) extinguish all naked flames prior to gluing, including, but not limited to, pilot lights, heaters etc; and
- (f) supply power to within eight (8) metres of the project; and
- (g) make the premises available on the agreed date and time. If installation is interrupted by the failure of the Client to adhere to the installation schedule agreed to between Regency Displays P/L the Supplier and the Client, any additional costs will be invoiced to the Client as an extra cost.
- (h) The Supplier is not insured to remove furniture or fittings and will not do so, nor is the Supplier licensed to move gas or electrical appliances, Note Please have all gas and or electrical points within the installation area de commissioned prior to commencement.
